Woman Gored by Bison in Yellowstone National Park

Always stay more than 25 yards (23 m) away from bison

- A 47-year-old female from Phoenix, Arizona, was gored by a bison near the Lake Lodge Cabins on the north shore of Lake Yellowstone the morning of July 17.
- The female was walking with another individual in a field in front of the Lake Lodge when they saw two bison. Upon seeing them, the visitors turned to walk away from the bison. One of the bison charged and gored the woman.
- The woman sustained significant injuries to her chest and abdomen and was transported by helicopter to Eastern Idaho Regional Medical Center.
- It is unknown how close the individuals were to the bison when it charged.
- This incident remains under investigation, and there is no additional information to share, including the woman's condition.
- Wildlife in Yellowstone National Park are wild and can be dangerous when approached. When an animal is near a campsite, trail, boardwalk, parking lot, or in a developed area, give it space. Stay more than 25 yards (23 m) away from all large animals bison, elk, bighorn sheep, deer, moose, and coyotes and at least 100 yards (91 m) away from bears and wolves. If need be, turn around and go the other way to avoid interacting with a wild animal in proximity.
- During mating season (rut) from mid-July through mid-August, bison can become agitated more quickly. Use extra caution and give them additional space during this time.
- Bison are unpredictable and can run three times faster than humans.
- Read more about <u>safety in the park</u>, including how to behave around wildlife.
- This is the first reported incident in 2023. The last reported incident occurred on June 28, 2022.

Recent Grizzly Bear Sightings ight the Importance of **Bear Awareness**

HELENA – This year Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks has confirmed grizzly bear sightings in several places where grizzlies haven't been seen in recent years, and in some cases more than a century.

Grizzly bear numbers and range continue to expand, particularly in areas between the Northern Continental Divide and the Great Yellowstone ecosystems.

Over the last couple of months, FWP staff have confirmed grizzly bear sightings in the North Hills and Grizzly Gulch areas near Helena, the Elkhorn Mountains near Clancy, near Ulm, in the Pryor Mountains southeast of Billings, the Shields Valley, Little Belt Mountains, near the Judith River east of Denton, and on the lower Dearborn River.

"Vigilance is important for those who live and recreate in the outdoors," said Quentin Kujala, chief of conservation policy for FWP. "This is a busy time of year for bears and our field staff are responding to calls in these particular areas and across the state."

As the grizzly bear population continues to expand across Montana, residents can take the following steps to help protect their property and be safe while recreating.

How to avoid attracting bears to your property

- Store garbage in an IGBC-certified bear resistant bin or other similarly resistant building or container at all times until the day of disposal.
- Avoid leaving food or smell attractants next to windows, doors or outside walls.
- Do not leave out pet food, bird feeders and bird seed or BBQ's.
- Bears are attracted to fruit-bearing trees and bushes, gardens and compost piles. Electric fencing can be effective at deterring bears as well as routinely picking fallen and ripe fruit.
- Secure vulnerable livestock (chickens, goats, sheep) with an <u>electric fence whenever possible.</u>

Tips for recreating in bear country

- Carry bear spray close at hand and know how to
- Travel in groups whenever possible and plan to be back to your vehicle in the daylight hours.
- Avoid carcass sites and concentrations of ravens and other scavengers.
- Watch for signs of bears such as bear scat, diggings, torn-up logs and turned over rocks, and partly consumed animal carcasses.
- Make noise, especially near streams or in thick forest where hearing and visibility is limited. This can be the key to avoiding encounters. Most bears will avoid humans when they know humans are present.
- Don't approach a bear.

Yellowstone Visitation Statistics for June 2023

MAMMOTH HOT SPRINGS, WY – The park hosted 847,864 recreation visits in June 2023. This is a 61% increase from June 2022, the month of the historic flood (525,363 recreational visits), and an 8% increase from June 2019* (781,853 recreation visits).

So far in 2023, the park has hosted 1,493,510 recreation visits, up 19% from 2022 (1,258,834 recreation visits), and up 10% from 2019 (1,358,629 recreation visits).

The list below shows the year-to-date trend for recreation visits over the last several years (through June):

2023 - 1,493,510

2022 – 1,258,834 (The park was closed June 13 - June 21. Three entrances opened June 22.)

2021 - 1,587,998

2020 - 719,054 (*The park was closed May 1 - May* 17. Two entrances opened May 18 and the remaining three opened June 1.)

2019 - 1,358,629

2018 - 1,381,708

Editor's note: *We compare 2023 visitation to 2019 visitation since 2019 was pre-COVID and the subsequent years until 2023 included unusual visitation trends due to COVID (2020, 2021) and the historic flood event in 2022 that closed the park for about two weeks in June.
