

It equips Park Gateway Partners with simple signage tools customized by type of business. Toolkits enable them to protect the town and bears from unsafe interactions by "training" their patrons to "stop training bears to get in trouble." Outreach is reinforced by a smartphone quiz they can take to get "Bearified" and receive a reward magnet.

Gardiner Resort Area Tax District Call for Projects

Annual resort tax collections go to set funds that include:

- 5% district operations
- 5% reimbursed to business collecting
- 10% property tax relief (credit on bill)
- 10% visitor center operations
- 15% visitor center capital grant
- 25% Special Project, Water District and open funds that can be applied for:
- 5% community services and cultural grants
- 50% infrastructure/community development

Who can apply? Any governmental unit, nonprofit corporation, or association that can be legally bound by the Agreement.

How to apply? Copies at Chamber or online

When are applications due? October 31

Make sure to Have Meat Tested for CWD Prior to Donation, Commercial Processing

HELENA – Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks along with the Montana Department of Health and Human Services are advising hunters to have their deer, elk and moose tested for chronic wasting disease (CWD). FWP strongly recommends that hunters receive a negative CWD test result before bringing their deer, elk or moose to a meat processor or donating it to a foodbank. While it is not a requirement, FWP is asking hunters to have a negative CWD test result in hand before bringing their animal to a processor for donation. If the animal tests positive for CWD, FWP will advise the hunter on proper carcass and meat disposal and give instructions on how to request a replacement license. There is no known transmission of CWD to humans. However, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends that hunters harvesting a deer, elk or moose from an area where CWD is known to be present have their animal tested for CWD prior to consuming the meat, and to not consume the meat if the animal tests positive. 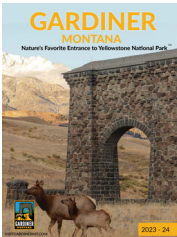

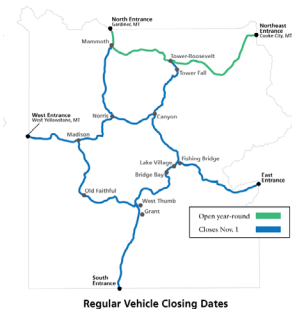

YNP Road Status & Current Conditions

Be prepared – there are several major road construction projects in YNP this year that may affect your journey into the park. All projects will cause **20 - 30+ minute delays**. Projects scheduled to last through October 31, 2023 are located at the intersection of NE Entrance Rd. & Tower Junction, Lamar Valley (NE Entrance Rd.), between Biscuit Basin and Grant Village (Grand Loop Rd.), and Lewis River Bridge (South Entrance Rd.); one-way traffic delays from Norris to Canyon are scheduled to last through September 30, 2023. **Don't be negligent - plan ahead, learn more about current YNP road status by scanning the QR Code.**
