

Yellowstone Visitation Statistics for September 2023

MAMMOTH HOT SPRINGS, WY – Yellowstone National Park hosted 838,458 recreation visits in September 2023. This is a 48% increase from September 2022 (567,587 recreational visits) and a 21% increase from September 2019* (693,118 recreational visits).

So far in 2023, the park has hosted 4,161,602 recreation visits, up 38% from 2022 (3,005,194 recreation visits), and up 9% from 2019 (3,807,815 recreation visits).

The list below shows the year-to-date trend for recreation visits over the last several years (through September):

2023 – 4,161,602

2022 - 3,005,194 (The park was closed June 13 through June 21. Three entrances opened on June 22.)

2021 – 4,472,687 **2020** – 3,393,642 (The park was closed March 24 through May 17. Two entrances opened on May 18 and the remaining three opened on June 1.)

2019 – 3,807,815 **2018** – 3,860,695

More data on park visitation, including how we calculate these numbers, is available on the NPS Stats website.

Editor's note: *We compare 2023 visitation to 2019 visitation since 2019 was pre-COVID and the subsequent years until 2023 included unusual visitation trends due to COVID (2020, 2021) and the historic flood event in 2022 that closed the park for about two weeks in June.

FWP, Montana Audubon Center hosting Bat-Stravaganza October 27

Free event with bat-themed educational activities for all ages

BILLINGS – Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks and the Montana Audubon Center are hosting Bat-Stravaganza, a family-friendly event focused on learning about and celebrating bats. The free event will take place Friday, Oct. 27, at the Montana Audubon Center (7026 S. Billings Blvd.) from 6-8 p.m. All ages are welcome.

Participants at Bat-Stravaganza will learn about threats to and benefits of bats, play educational games, explore a "bat cave," and make bat-themed crafts. Halloween costumes are encouraged. Prizes, snacks, and fun giveaways will be available.

Bats provide a variety of benefits to humans and the ecosystem, such as crop protection, insect pest control and pollination. In Montana, there are 15 different species of bats, 11 of which are considered "Species of Concern" due threats such as habitat loss and white nose syndrome. Bat-Stravaganza will take place during Bat Week, an international, annual celebration held the last week of October. The goal of Bat Week is to raise awareness about bat conservation and improve public perception of these unique and important animals. For more information on Bat Week, visit: batweek.org. Rifle Season Opener Reminders

Youth-Only Deer Hunt Comes Just Before General Season Opener

HELENA - Montana's annual youth-only deer hunt is set for Oct. 19-20 this year.

The two-day youth hunt is open to:

- legally licensed 12 to 15-year-olds who have completed hunter education and who are accompanied by a non-hunting adult at least 18 years of age;
- and properly certified and legally licensed apprentice hunters 10-15 years of age who are accompanied by a non-hunting adult "mentor" at least 21 years of age.

This hunt is for deer only. All regulations apply. Elk hunting is prohibited. Young hunters must wear hunter orange and follow all hunting district regulations, which may limit them to certain species or require a special permit. Learn more by visiting: https://fwp.mt.gov/

Ask First to Hunt on Private Land

HELENA - Don't wait until it is too late. Hunters who haven't already asked permission from private landowners to hunt need to do so as soon as possible.

Montana law requires hunters to obtain permission for all hunting on private land. Whether pursuing upland game birds, coyotes, gophers or any other wildlife, hunters must have permission from the landowner before hunting on private property. This also includes entering private land to retrieve wildlife or to access public land to hunt.

Landowners may grant permission in person, over the phone, in writing or by posting signs that explain what type of hunting is allowed and under what conditions hunting may occur on land owned or controlled by the landowner. Learn more by visiting: https://fwp.mt.gov/

Turn in Poachers Call 1-800-TIP-MONT

HELENA - The Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks toll-free hotline for reporting wildlife poaching, property damage, and violations of fish and game laws is in operation 24 hours a day.

TIP-MONT is the acronym for Turn in Poachers—Montana. Poaching includes:

- hunting out of season or at night using spotlights
- taking more than one's legal limit
- nonresidents who purchase resident licenses
- professional and commercial poachers who illegally offer outfitter and guide services.

When it comes to poaching, Montanans are saying, "Enough is enough!"

If you witness a fish and game violation, or property vandalism, you can report the crime by calling 1-800-TIP-MONT (1-800-847-6668); or Report a Violation online at fwp.mt.gov, then click Enforcement.

Callers may remain anonymous and may be eligible for a cash reward. Learn more by visiting: https://fwp.mt.gov/

"I Am Bear Safe" is a partnership effort of Yellowstone gateway town businesses with Grizzly & Wolf Discovery Center, Bear Awareness Gardiner, and Wildlife Restoration Foundation. It equips Park Gateway Partners with simple signage tools customized by type of business. Toolkits enable them to protect the town and bears from unsafe interactions by "training" their patrons to "stop training bears to get in trouble." Outreach is reinforced by a smartphone quiz they can take to get "Bearified" and receive a reward magnet.





YNP Road Status & Current Conditions

Be prepared - there are several major road construction projects in YNP this year that may affect your journey into the park. All projects will cause **20 - 30+ minute delays**. Projects scheduled to last through October 31, 2023 are located at the intersection of NE Entrance Rd. & Tower Junction, Lamar Valley (NE Entrance Rd.), between Biscuit Basin and Grant Village (Grand Loop Rd.), and Lewis Ŕiver Bridge (South Entrance Rd.); one-way traffic delays from Norris to Canyon are scheduled to last through September 30, 2023. **Don't be negligent - plan ahead, learn more about current YNP road status by scanning the QR Code.**
