Mule Deer Tests Positive for Chronic Wasting Disease in Yellowstone National Park

Guidance for Park Visitors

MAMMOTH HOT SPRINGS, WY – Yellowstone National Park and the Wyoming Game and Fish Department (WGFD) recently confirmed the presence of [chronic wasting disease](#) (CWD) in the carcass of an adult mule deer buck found near Yellowstone Lake in the southeastern section of the park. This is the first confirmed positive detection of the disease in Yellowstone National Park.

The [mule deer](#) buck was originally captured by WGFD staff near Cody, Wyoming, in March 2023 as part of a population dynamics study and fitted with a GPS collar. The collar signaled the animal died mid-October 2023. In coordination with Yellowstone staff, WGFD located the carcass on the Promontory, a landmass that separates the South and Southeast arms of Yellowstone Lake and collected samples for testing. The samples tested positive for CWD based on multiple diagnostic tests performed at WGFD’s Wildlife Health Laboratory.

Next steps

- Yellowstone staff will prioritize the following actions to manage the disease as there is no effective strategy to eradicate it once established.
- Increase collaboration and information sharing with [WGFD](#) and other state agencies to identify areas within Yellowstone with increased risk for CWD.
 - Increase monitoring for the presence of CWD in other deer, elk and moose in the park.
 - Increase the investigation of carcasses and collection of samples for testing.

What is chronic wasting disease?

- CWD is a contagious, fatal disease of deer, elk and moose caused by a malformed protein (prion) for which there is no vaccine or known treatment.
- The malformed prion protein accumulates in the brain and other tissues causing physiological and behavioral changes, emaciation and death.
- Signs of CWD include listlessness, weight loss, increased drinking and urinating, excessive drooling and head lowering.
- It is transmitted by direct animal-to-animal contact or indirectly through contact with infectious particles persisting in the environment such as feces, soil or vegetation.
- Since the mid-1980s, CWD has [spread across Wyoming](#) and is now found in most of the state.
- About 10-15% of the mule deer near Cody, Wyoming, that migrate into the southeast portion of Yellowstone during summer months are estimated to have CWD.
- The long-term effect of CWD on deer, elk and moose in the Yellowstone area is uncertain.

Guidance for park visitors

- Most wild animals in Yellowstone are healthy and thrive in their natural environment, but sometimes wildlife can get sick just like people.
- If you see any sick or dead wildlife, notify a National Park Service (NPS) employee as soon as possible and avoid contact with the animal.
- Avoid touching or handling sick or dead wild animals as some disease-causing organisms can be passed between wild animals and people.
- NPS employees trained in wildlife health use specific protective measures to safely deal with a wild animal that may have died of disease.
- It is recommended that people avoid consumption of any part of an animal that is suspected or confirmed to have CWD.
- There is currently no evidence that CWD can infect humans or domestic animal species. However, it is recommended that tissues from CWD-infected animals not be consumed.

Editor’s note: Yellowstone is currently revising its 2021 Chronic Wasting Disease Surveillance Plan due to the recent detection and anticipate its completion in 2024.

Yellowstone Visitation Statistics for October 2023

MAMMOTH HOT SPRINGS, WY – Yellowstone National Park hosted 299,127 recreation visits in October 2023. This is a 26% increase from October 2022 (236,567 recreational visits). It is also a 75% increase from October 2019* (171,339 recreational visits) when several short-term, weather-related road closures likely impacted visitation.

So far in 2023, the park has hosted 4,446,509 recreation visits, up 37% from 2022 (3,241,761 recreation visits), and up 12% from 2019 (3,979,154 recreation visits).

The list below shows the year-to-date trend for recreation visits over the last several years (through October):

- 2023** – 4,446,509
- 2022** – 3,241,761 (The park was closed June 13 through June 21. Three entrances opened on June 22.)
- 2021** – 4,789,349
- 2020** – 3,753,531 (The park was closed March 24 through May 17. Two entrances opened on May 18 and the remaining three opened on June 1.)
- 2019** – 3,979,154
- 2018** – 4,078,771

*Editor’s note: *We compare 2023 visitation to 2019 visitation since 2019 was pre-COVID and the subsequent years until 2023 included unusual visitation trends due to COVID (2020, 2021) and the [historic flood](#) event in 2022 that closed the park for about two weeks in June.*

Glacier National Park Announces a Pilot Vehicle Reservation System in 2024

WEST GLACIER, Mont. – [Glacier National Park](#) will implement a pilot vehicle reservation system in 2024, beginning May 24 for the west side of Going-to-the-Sun Road and North Fork and on July 1 for Many Glacier.

“Our balanced approach for the 2024 pilot reflects feedback from Tribes, the public, partners, and stakeholders, particularly regarding access to the Apgar Village area and Two Medicine,” said Glacier National Park Superintendent Dave Roemer. “We also heard that knowing what park operations and access will look like sooner, rather than later, is important.”
