Wyatt Evan Lewis, 42, of Ocean View, Hawaii passed away in late October 2023, the victim of an apparent homicide and robbery which is still under investigation. Wyatt was born in Luther, Montana on August 9, 1981 to William Britt Lewis and Kathy Pauline Lewis.



Wyatt grew up in Gardiner, Montana and in Grants, New Mexico. In 2001, Wyatt married Bobbie Starkweather and had one child, Jonathan Ace Lewis. Wyatt worked in Gardiner at the Corral during high school, then as a cook at The Grand Hotel and The Rib and Chop House. Wyatt attended WyoTech in Laramie, Wyoming. After graduation he moved to Big Timber,

Montana where he gained employment with Stillwater Mining Company. That was the jumpstart to Wyatt's life career, shaft mining. Wyatt worked as a shaft miner from California to New York and Louisiana to Idaho but he spent most of his mining career in the western states.

Wyatt was an avid sportsman and he loved to travel. He had the biggest heart and would do anything to help a friend in need. Wyatt was amazingly strong inside and out, earning him the nickname "Hercules" from his fellow miners. In 2022, while vacationing in Hawaii, he purchased property in Ocean View on the Island of Hawaii. He returned in August 2023 with plans to build his own home. He had help from friends that he met in Hawaii and his younger brother Weston, who joined him for the construction project. Wyatt had nearly completed his dream home before his death.

Wyatt is survived by many family members: Son, Ace Lewis and Ex-Wife Bobbie Starkweather, Mother Kate Lewis and Father Britt Lewis and Step-Mother Mila Lewis. Wyatt had six brothers and two sisters: Kelly Smith, Corey McKown, Ira Lewis, Hattie Lewis, Tucker Lewis, Weston Lewis, Franklin Lewis and Samantha Lewis. Wyatt is also survived by many nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles, and extended friends and family. Due to the circumstances of Wyatt's death, his family is heart-sick at the waste of the life of such a vibrant person as Wyatt, he will be sorely missed.

Wolf season to close in WMU 313

HELENA – The wolf harvest quota of six wolves in wolf management unit (WMU) 313 has been reached. The wolf season in WMU 313 will close one half hour after sunset on Dec. 27. Regulations state: "when a quota is reached, the hunting and trapping season for the state, the region and/or WMU will close upon a 24-hour notice." The latest wolf was harvested Dec. 25. WMU 313 borders the northern boundary of Yellowstone National Park. The 2023/2024 Wolf and Furbearer Regulations were set earlier this year by the Montana Fish and Wildlife Commission. Hunters and trappers who harvest a wolf in Montana must report their harvest within 24 hours. The wolf harvest dashboard tracks wolf harvest in the state and can be viewed here.

FWP to Require Field Day for Youth Who Take Hunter or Bowhunter Education Online

HELENA - Starting Jan. 1, Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks will require Hunter and Bowhunter Education students age 12 to 17 who take the online course to pass an in-person field day. Students in that age group must pass both the online exam and the field day to earn a course completion certificate. For Hunter Education, the in-person field day will require students to practice and demonstrate key safety skills related to firearm handling, the four main rules of firearm safety, and the PROVE procedure, which stands for "Point, Remove, Observe, Verify, and Examine." Students will demonstrate how to safely cross a fence with a firearm, hand off a firearm, and remove a firearm from a vehicle, among other practical safety skills. In addition, students will discuss hunting ethics, landowner relations, land ownership and access, FWP's Block Management Program, wildlife conservation, and more. In-person field days for Bowhunter Education will similarly feature hands-on safety practice and demonstrations. Students who are 12 to 17 and are currently in progress with the online Hunter or Bowhunter Education courses must complete their coursework before Jan. 1, or they will be required to complete an in-person field day. Montana law requires everyone born after Jan. 1, 1985, to complete a Hunter or Bowhunter Education course before purchasing or applying for Montana hunting licenses. Students 10 years and older can take an in-person course. Students 18 and older can take the online-only course. Instructor-led in-person courses are an excellent way to provide new hunters with a handson learning experience and can be particularly beneficial for people who have minimal experience in the field or handling firearms. These courses are taught by dedicated volunteer instructors, often from local communities.
