


LOCAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

Wyatt Evan Lewis, 42, of Ocean View, Hawaii passed away in late October 2023, the victim of an apparent homicide and robbery which is still under investigation. Wyatt was born in Luther, Montana on August 9, 1981 to William Britt Lewis and Kathy Pauline Lewis.



Wyatt grew up in Gardiner, Montana and in Grants, New Mexico. In 2001, Wyatt married Bobbie Starkweather and had one child, Jonathan Ace Lewis. Wyatt worked in Gardiner at the Corral during high school, then as a cook at The Grand Hotel and The Rib and Chop House. Wyatt attended WyoTech in Laramie, Wyoming. After graduation he moved to Big Timber,

Montana where he gained employment with Stillwater Mining Company. That was the jumpstart to Wyatt's life career, shaft mining. Wyatt worked as a shaft miner from California to New York and Louisiana to Idaho but he spent most of his mining career in the western states.

Wyatt was an avid sportsman and he loved to travel. He had the biggest heart and would do anything to help a friend in need. Wyatt was amazingly strong inside and out, earning him the nickname "Hercules" from his fellow miners. In 2022, while vacationing in Hawaii, he purchased property in Ocean View on the Island of Hawaii. He returned in August 2023 with plans to build his own home. He had help from friends that he met in Hawaii and his younger brother Weston, who joined him for the construction project. Wyatt had nearly completed his dream home before his death.

Wyatt is survived by many family members: Son, Ace Lewis and Ex-Wife Bobbie Starkweather, Mother Kate Lewis and Father Britt Lewis and Step-Mother Mila Lewis. Wyatt had six brothers and two sisters: Kelly Smith, Corey McKown, Ira Lewis, Hattie Lewis, Tucker Lewis, Weston Lewis, Franklin Lewis and Samantha Lewis. Wyatt is also survived by many nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles, and extended friends and family. Due to the circumstances of Wyatt's death, his family is heart-sick at the waste of the life of such a vibrant person as Wyatt, he will be sorely missed.

Application Period Started Jan. 2 for Smith River Permits

Changes coming for the 2024 season

HELENA – Floaters hoping for a Smith River permit can apply Jan. 2 through Feb. 14. However, a few changes are coming this year that applicants should be aware of.

Celebrated for its spectacular scenery, remote location and excellent trout fishing, the Smith River is one of Montana's most sought-after outdoor recreation experiences. Permits are required to float the 59-mile section of river between Camp Baker and Eden Bridge and are issued each year through a lottery. Parties of up to 15 people can float with one permit. A person applying for a Smith River permit must be a minimum of 12 years of age at the time they submit their permit application.

Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks staff will remove pit toilets at the boat camps along the Smith River during the spring of 2024. All float parties, private and commercial, will be required to pack out their human waste from the Smith River corridor. This requirement is similar to many other river systems in the West and necessary to keep the corridor pristine for visitors now and for decades to come. The rules implementing this pack-out system were passed by the Montana Parks Board in early 2022.

Floaters will need to pack portable toilet systems. To see a list of FWP-approved, portable, hard-sided toilets that will be allowed, <u>click here</u>. Alternative waste disposal systems, including bag systems, such as Clean Waste and RESTOP2, will not be allowed.

Floaters can clean and sanitize their portable toilet system with a SCAT (Sanitizing Containers with Alternative Technology) machine, which has been installed at the Eden Bridge take-out.

"Removal of the pit toilets will not only help reduce impacts to natural and cultural resources, but also allow more time for the river rangers to focus on other duties, such as public safety and recreation ecology projects like noxious weed control and stabilizing erosion at boat camp landings," said Colin Maas, FWP Recreation Manager for the Smith River.

2024 is the first year applicants can buy a bonus point for the Smith River Permit. A bonus point is essentially an extra chance you can purchase for the permit drawing. These points accumulate year after year if you are unsuccessful in the drawing. Residents can purchase a bonus point for \$5; nonresidents can purchase a bonus point for \$50. The bonus point is applied to your application the year it is purchased. You can apply for a permit through FWP's online licensing system.

Also starting in 2024, the number of permits available for nonresidents may not exceed 10 percent of the available permits. This new law was passed as part of House Bill 846 in the 2023 Legislative Session.

Protect Your Park: Protect Yourself

Yellowstone's scenic wonders are sure to take your breath away: don't let them take your life. From boiling hot springs to thousands of wild animals, some of the hazards in Yellowstone will be new to you. Protect yourself and the sights you plan to enjoy by following a few simple rules:

Never approach wildlife

The animals in Yellowstone are wild and unpredictable, no matter how calm they appear to be. The safest (and often best) view of wildlife is from inside a car. Always stay at least 100 yards (91 m) away from bears and wolves, and at least 25 yards (23 m) away from all other animals, including bison and elk.

• Stay on boardwalks and trails in thermal areas

Hot springs have injured or killed more people in Yellowstone than any other natural feature. Keep your children close and don't let them run.

Never feed wildlife

Animals that become dependent on human food may become aggressive toward people and have to be killed. Keep all food, garbage, or other smelly items packed away when not in use

Never park in the road or block traffic

Use pullouts to watch wildlife and let other cars pass. Stay with your vehicle if you encounter a wildlife jam.

We can't guarantee your safety in Yellowstone, but these concepts will help you avoid the most common accidents. See below for more great advice, and be sure to review our <u>Rules & Regulations</u>, <u>Laws & Policies</u>, and tips for <u>backcountry travel</u>.
