The Civil Rights Act of 1964: Making Our Nation Whole

When President Lyndon Johnson signed the Civil Rights Act into law on July 2, 1964, he said that "the purpose of the law is simple. It does not restrict the freedom of any American, so long as he respects the rights of others."

The act was a major turning point in U.S. history. It moved toward ending the <u>Jim Crow</u> laws that had held sway in many areas of the U.S. for years, and paved the way for future reform legislation.

But while the purpose of the law might have been simple, the act itself was not. As one of the most ambitious pieces of civil rights legislation since the Reconstruction era, it addressed inequality in many different areas of American life.


It prohibited employment discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, sex or national origin in many businesses. It called for the desegregation of public schools. It outlawed segregation in hotels, theaters, restaurants, and many other public spaces. It eliminated the discriminatory use of voter registration requirements.

Free Business Consulting with MSU Extension and PLDC

Park Local Development Corporation and MSU Extension received a grant to help spread local knowledge to our business community. We created a team of Park County residents with valuable expertise and are paying for the first 3 hours of consulting and their travel around the county to help out businesses.

The team is called the Business Consulting and Resiliency Team (BCR Team)

Here is a brief overview of the process for the BCR Team:

Initial Interview: Park Local Development Corporation will conduct an initial interview with the business interested in receiving free consulting services paid for by Park Local.

Pair Business with a Consultant: Based on the information gathered, Park Local will recommend consultants who can make the most impact. The business will select their preferred consultant from the provided list.

Consulting Session: The consultant will then set up a time to meet with the business, either at the business, or a mutually agreed upon location. The schedule should accommodate the business's needs—whether a one-time, three-hour session or three one-hour sessions.

Invoice and Exit Interview: Once the sessions have been completed, the consultant will send us an invoice for their time, and mileage if assisting a business in Gardiner or Cooke City. Park Local will also conduct an exit interview with the business to review the recommended changes and their overall experience with the process.

Long Term Follow up: After 6 months, we will check in with the businesses to see if they implemented the changes suggested and assess their progress.



Montana Files Notice of Intent to Sue Over Wolverine Listing

HELENA – Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks has notified the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS) of its intent to pursue legal action over the recent listing of wolverines as a threatened species.

"In Montana, wolverines continue to do well and inhabit much, if not all, of their available habitat," said Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks Chief of Conservation Policy Quentin Kujala. "We work closely with our neighboring states to ensure the continued conservation of these iconic species. Federal protections in this case will only get in the way of good conservation work."

In its listing notice, the FWS switched course by identifying the lower 48 states as a distinct population segment. This finding comes after the FWS previously found the population of wolverines in the lower 48 was connected to those in Canada. The finding came despite protections in Canada and states like Montana to ensure wolverine conservation. In its listing, the FWS also used climate models from the year 2100 to point to a projected decrease in snowpack to justify its move. This rationale was used despite recent science that shows wolverines are adaptable and able to den and reproduce without snow.

"In the Northern Rockies, wolverines are doing well and states are working closely on monitoring and conservation efforts. This listing is not only unnecessary, it fails to recognize current science," said FWP Director Dustin Temple.

Wolverines were listed as a threatened species by the FWS in November. The first step in challenging this listing is filing a Notice of Intent to Sue with the FWS. Following this action, the state will file a lawsuit in federal district court.


