
ON TUESDAY, JAN. 30 AT 7 A.M., the road from West Entrance to Old Faithful converted to wheeled vehicles for administrative travel and Overnsnow contract holders due to deteriorating oversnow conditions and an unfavorable forecast for warm temperatures and lack of snow. The speed limit is 25 mph for all traffic. The Madison to Norris to Canyon corridor will continue to have snowmobile and oversnow vehicle traffic as long as conditions allow. The park will continue to meet with the operators regularly to assess conditions, seek their feedback and share safety messaging. Bare pavement, thin snow coverage, icy and slushy surfaces can present a significant safety hazard. If travelling on a snowmobile, keep your speeds low, and always check the Park Roads webpage for the most current conditions. Reminder: travel on the West Entrance to Old Faithful corridor is still for OSV contract holders and administrative travel only.



## Public Input Sought on Yellowstone National Park's North Entrance Road

Virtual public meetings Feb. 12 and Feb. 14; 30-day public comment period begins Feb. 12

MAMMOTH HOT SPRINGS, WY – The National Park Service (NPS), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration, is considering construction of a new permanent North Entrance Road in Yellowstone National Park. Goals for the new road include providing year-round access between Gardiner, Montana, and Cooke City/Silver Gate, Montana, natural hazard resiliency and the protection of natural and cultural resources.

Yellowstone invites the public to learn about and provide input on the North Entrance Road project by way of virtual public meetings on Feb. 12 and Feb. 14. A 30-day public comment period will also begin Feb. 12. Public input will help Yellowstone select an alignment and begin the environmental compliance process.

Yellowstone experienced a 500-year flood event on June 13, 2022. The flood destroyed infrastructure in the northern portion of the park including several sections of the North Entrance Road between Mammoth Hot Springs and Gardiner, Montana, and segments of the Northeast Entrance Road between Tower Junction and Cooke City/Silver Gate, Montana. Both roads are open year-round and serve as the only winter vehicle access in and out of the park. After temporarily closing to regular visitor traffic on June 13, 2022, the Northeast Entrance Road opened to the public on Oct. 15, 2022, and a temporary road between Gardiner and Mammoth Hot Springs opened to the public on Oct. 30, 2022.

## **Virtual Public Meetings**

During each meeting, three preliminary road alignment alternatives will be presented along with two video flyovers to explain the damage, environmental challenges, constraints and opportunities of each alignment. Meeting details include:

#### **Public Comment**

Beginning Feb. 12, the public can also provide formal comments. Comments may also be mailed or hand-delivered to: Yellowstone Center for Resources Attn: North Entrance Road EA, PO Box 168, Yellowstone National Park, WY 82190. The deadline to submit comments is Wednesday, March 13.

At the conclusion of the 30-day public comment period, the NPS will analyze and consider all comments received. A draft environmental assessment will likely be released for public review fall 2024. A final decision is expected in early 2025.

On April 25, 2023, award winning singer, actor, and human rights activist Harry Belafonte passed away at the age of 96 in New York City, New York. His long and successful career garnered him many awards, accolades, and honors for his talent, creativity, and dedication to equality. Belafonte was one of a very few people to win an Emmy, Grammy, Oscar, and Tony (EGOT) awards. He is best known for his song "Day-O (The Banana Boat Song)" and portraying Dorothy Dandridge's love interest in the 1954 film Carmen Jones. Belafone received a Kennedy Center Honor in 1989, the National Medal of Arts in 1994, the Bishop John T. Walker Distinguished Humanitarian Service Award from Africare in 2002, and was inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 2022. Belafonte was also awarded an honorary doctorate from Berklee College of Music in Boston and was an honorary member of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc.





## **Proposed I 90 Striping Upgrade**

GALLATIN AND PARK COUNTIES, Mont. - The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) would like to announce and invite the public to comment on a proposal to upgrade striping on about 38 miles of Interstate 90 (I 90), in both the eastbound and westbound lanes, between Manhattan and Livingston. Work will be completed in two sections. The first section begins near the Manhattan Interchange (Exit 288) and extends east, ending at the Jackson Creek Interchange (Exit 319). The second section begins just west of the Old Highway 10 Livingston Interchange (Exit 330) and extends east, ending at the US Highway 89 (US 89) Livingston Interchange (Exit 337).

Proposed work includes restriping the fog lines and centerline with inlaid 6-inch striping. This is a proven safety countermeasure. The purpose of the project is to enhance roadway safety features in response to single vehicle road departure related crashes.

Construction is tentatively planned for 2024 depending on completion of design and availability of funds.

Partnering with the community is an important part of properly planning for future projects. MDT welcomes the public to provide ideas and comments on the proposed project.
