

Reggie Watts - Comedian, Actor, Beatboxer & Musician https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Reggie_Watts


Reginald Lucien Frank Roger Watts (born March 23, 1972) is an American comedian, actor, beatboxer, and musician. His improvised musical sets are created using only his voice, a keyboard, and a looping machine. Watts refers to himself as a "disinformationist" who aims to disorient his audience in a comedic fashion. He was the regular house musician on the spoof IFC talk show Comedy Bang! Bang!. From 2015 to 2023, Watts led the house band for The Late Late Show with James Corden.

Watts utilizes improvisation in his solo shows, which consist of him singing and rapping both with words and with sound poetry, accompanying himself by either beatboxing, performing vocal basslines into a loop machine, or simply by playing the keyboard. His act also showcases his trademark style of stand-up comedy, consisting of him rapidly alternating between topics of discussion in both rational and nonsensical manners, making random sounds and gibberish noises, and speaking in other accents and languages at unexpected times, all with the intent of playfully and comically disorienting his audiences. He has a four-and-a-half octave vocal range.

Public Scoping Begins for Glacier National Park's Fire Management Plan FA

WEST GLACIER, Mont. [February 27, 2024] – Glacier National Park is initiating public scoping for an environmental assessment (EA) in compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) to update a long-term Fire Management Plan (FMP) for Glacier National Park.

The park's FMP and EA were last updated in 2003. As part of its mission, the NPS Wildland Fire Program manages wildland fire and fuel treatments to protect the public, park communities, and infrastructure; conserve natural and cultural resources; and maintain and restore natural ecosystem processes. The 2006 NPS Management Policies require each park unit with burnable vegetation to have an approved FMP.

An updated FMP is needed to ensure Glacier's fire management guidelines are consistent with current conditions and the latest NPS guidance, and to continue to provide for firefighter and public safety, protect park values and resources, and remain consistent with the park's resource management objectives.

The proposed plan would provide a framework and parkwide guidelines for the management of all wildfires, regardless of cause, size, or complexity. The plan would provide guidance on the use of prescribed fire and non-fire fuels treatments to reduce hazardous fuel loading and accomplish resource protection objectives. The plan would provide for firefighter and public safety, consider the ecological benefits of wildland fire, and remain consistent with Glacier's resource management goals.

Comments by email or phone will not be accepted. Please provide comments by March 27, 2024.

Food Storage Requirements Reinstated March 1, 2024

Bozeman, MT, February 27, 2024 – Effective March 1, 2024, food storage regulations will be reinstated annually from March 1- December 1, 2024, across five ranger districts within the Custer Gallatin National Forest: Bozeman, Hebgen Lake, Gardiner, Yellowstone, and Beartooth. These measures aim to reduce potential adverse human/wildlife interactions including bear and other wildlife species. The food storage order requires that all attractants, which include food and beverages, refuse, animal carcasses, and items that have food smells or other odors (toiletries, cosmetics, pet food, coolers, bird feeders, etc.), be attended or stored using an approved method.

The Food Storage Order requires that all unattended food, garbage and attractants be stored through one of the approved methods:

- In hard-sided vehicles or enclosed trailers;
- In bear-resistant containers or other approved products.
 A list of approved bear-resistant storage products can be found at www.igbconline.org; or
- Suspended at least 10 feet above the ground, and 4 feet away from adjacent trees/poles, out of the reach of wildlife:

Individuals who do not comply with the food storage order can be issued a violation and held civilly liable for any damages that occur from non-compliance. It is always good practice to maintain a clean camp and keep food properly stored in containers out of the reach of wildlife and secured for both the safety of bears, other wildlife and for human safety.




325.5 Million Visits to National Parks in 2023, 4.5 Million Visits to Yellowstone National Park

MAMMOTH HOT SPRINGS, WY – On <u>Feb. 22</u>, the National Park Service (NPS) announced that 400 national parks reported a total of 325.5 million recreation visits in 2023, an increase of 13 million or 4% over 2022.

Yellowstone National Park hosted 4,501,382 recreation visits in 2023, up 37% over 2022 (3,290,242 recreation visits). Lower visitation numbers in 2022 were likely due to an historic flood event that closed the park from June 13 through June 21. Three entrances opened June 22 and two remained closed until October.

In 2023, visitation was the second busiest on record. The busiest year was 2021 with 4,860,242 recreational visits. More than half of these visits for both years occurred in June, July and August. Visitors looking to travel to Yellowstone in the summer must plan a visit well in advance.

Visitation figures and trends guide how the NPS manages parks to ensure the best experience possible for park visitors. The <u>Visitation Statistics Dashboard</u> provides recreational visit statistics for every park in the US for 2023 and also for previous years, dating back to 1979 for some parks. There are 429 parks in the National Park System, and 400 parks counted visitors in 2023. For the first time, there are now parks reporting their visitation numbers from all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and four US territories. Five national parks began reporting in 2023, and this is the first year a park from Delaware is included.
