South Crazy Mountains Land Exchange Decision Released

Bozeman, MT (May 3, 2021)... The Custer Gallatin National Forest has released the Final Environmental Assessment, Finding of No Significant Impact, and Final Decision Notice for the South Crazy Mountains Land Exchange. The Crazy Mountains are located northeast of Livingston, Montana and northwest of Big Timber, Montana. The decision exchanges approximately 1,920 acres of National Forest System lands for 1877.5 acres of private lands owned by Wild Eagle Mountain Ranch (WEMR) and Rock Creek Ranch (RCR).

The decision improves long-term management effectiveness by consolidating public lands and improving access to NFS lands with the acquisition of road easements.

In the fall of 2019, the Custer Gallatin National Forest released for review and public comment a proposed land exchange between the Forest Service and three separate landowners in the southern Crazy Mountains: Crazy Mountain Ranch (CMR), WEMR and RCR. These three ranches were evaluated together for environmental analysis purposes, though the proposal also outlined that the parcels could each be considered individually.

On December 10, 2020 the Forest released the South Crazy Mountains Land Exchange Environmental Assessment, Finding of No Significant Impact and Draft Decision Notice. The draft decision called for moving forward with the WEMR and RCR exchanges, but in response to public input did not make a decision on the CMR exchange component and forest officials determined that more time and consideration were needed regarding the CMR exchange before making a decision on that exchange. The Final Decision released today does not move forward with the CMR component of the exchange but retains the Forest's ability to move forward in the future

"During the multiple public comment opportunities and the 45 day objection period we heard tremendous passion for access and public lands in the Crazy Mountains, and consistent support for the WEMR and RCR portions of the proposal," said Kathy Minor, Acting Forest Supervisor, Custer Gallatin National Forest. "I am excited to bring this piece of the South Crazy Project to a Decision. We look forward to working with the community, landowners and stakeholders to tackle other important lands work across the Forest."

Additional GNP Entry Reservation Tickets Available May 5

Glacier National Park to release additional tickets for entry onto Going-to-the-Sun Road for reservations beginning July 1.

WEST GLACIER, Mont. [May 4, 2021]– Glacier National Park announces the release of additional Going-to-the-Sun entry reservation tickets for entry as early as July 1. The additional tickets will be available starting on May 5 at 8 am MDT on Recreation.gov.

Up to this point, a smaller amount of tickets has been available because the road is not fully open over Logan Pass. However, park officials have determined that the road should be open by July 1. This means more tickets are being released on May 5 on Recreation.gov for 60-day advance purchase. This will also increase the number of tickets being held for release for the two-day advance purchase for reservations beginning July 1.

Based on historical data, the Going-to-the-Sun Road typically opens prior to July 1. The actual date for the road opening cannot be predicted at this time. As we get closer to the actual road opening date, additional tickets will be released. Visitors are encouraged to keep watching Recreation.gov for ticket availability.
