

# Dude Ranch Vacations at Historic O.T.O. Dude Ranch Offer Excursions with **Local Autfitters**

Gardiner, MT (March 28, 2023) — Dude ranch guests are welcomed back to the O.T.O. Dude Ranch this summer for a second season since the ranch closed to dudes over 80 years ago. Guests will experience the historic ranch and Yellowstone Country with on ranch activities including horseback riding, and off-ranch excursions with local outfitters in Gardiner, Montana; as well as tours of Yellowstone National Park with Yellowstone Forever.

The 2023 Yellowstone Pop-Up Ranch is an all-inclusive dude ranch experience produced by True Ranch Collection in cooperation with Custer Gallatin National Forest offering three- and six-night stays from June 25 to August 12, 2023. A portion of each reservation and all proceeds will be donated toward efforts to preserve and restore the ranch, which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Guests returning to the historically significant O.T.O. will experience horseback riding and outdoor activities, lodging in the historic guest cabins, inclusive dining, and special events and entertainment. This summer's guests will also experience off-ranch excursions with local outfitters to explore even more of Yellowstone Country.

A full day tour of Yellowstone National Park by Yellowstone Forever will be offered to guests staying six nights. The O.T.O. is just 10 miles from the North Entrance of Yellowstone, and this special tour will provide guests with an in-depth look at some of the Park's incredible natural features and wildlife.

Additionally, all guests will be able to participate in white water rafting with Flying Pig Adventure Company, located in nearby Gardiner. Flying Pig's experienced guides will take guests for a float down the Yellowstone River navigating calm waters and challenging rapids.

After days spent in the saddle, the newest O.T.O. dudes can enjoy a relaxing soak in the mineral-rich pools of the Yellowstone Hot Springs. The hot springs are nestled along the banks of the Yellowstone River, just a few miles from the ranch.

The O.T.O. Dude Ranch, known as the first in Montana, lies along Cedar Creek in the Absaroka Mountains. Early 20th century dudes were drawn to the O.T.O. to experience the western lifestyle and a new type of outdoor Montana vacation until dude ranching operations ceased in 1939. True Ranch Collection's Yellowstone Pop-Up Ranch will be produced in cooperation with Custer Gallatin National Forest, which has stewarded modern preservation efforts of the O.T.O. True Ranch Collection will be operating under a one-year permit to facilitate offering this opportunity to the public. Any long-term permitting of the O.T.O. Dude Ranch will be through an open and transparent public process.

### Future Fisheries Improvement Program Grant Deadline is May 15

HELENA - Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks reminds landowners, watershed groups and others that this summer's deadline to apply for Future Fisheries Improvement Program (FFIP) grants is May 15.

The goal of FWP's Future Fisheries Program is to restore rivers, streams and lakes to improve Montana's wild fish habitat. Entities can receive funding for qualifying projects that benefit Montana's wild fish. Each project is assessed by an independent review panel, and final funding decisions are made by the Fish and Wildlife Commission.

#### How many bears does it take to screw in a light bulb?

We're not sure, but you don't want to meet even *one* bear in a dark alley.

How can using a bear-resistant bear can help? Because of the way they are built, the cans tumble and slip around but bears can't get inside them. A hungry bear quickly learns not to waste energy on hanging around bear-cans that may smell good but don't deliver any food. Bears are that smart. But *only you* can screw in a light bulb—and figure out how to coexist with bears.

Gardiner is in the middle of the spring and fall bear migration route. Bear-resistant garbage cans are our first line of defense against bear problems.

Bear Awareness Gardiner gives out one free can to every residence in the Gardiner area. If you need a bear-can, call Evan at 207-441-7199.

Bears aren't the only ones who need reminders: Please, please...

- Lock all empty or full bear-resistant cans, always. That frustrating smell is still there!
- Do not drop trash in any container except a bear-resistant garbage can. Do not drop garbage in someone else's private garbage can, especially if it is not a bear-resistant garbage can.
- VRBO and Air B&B hosts, please tell your guests to use only designated bear-resistant cans. We can help you get one.
- Use public bear-resistant cans at locations throughout Gardiner. But please do not overstuff the cans.
- Lock away grills and dog food.
- Stop feeding the birds in spring and fall.
- Carry bear spray when hiking or hunting.
- Call out if you cannot see ahead on hiking trails.

BAG is helping businesses afford commercial grade cans and other bear proofing through our Business Cost-Sharing program. Businesses in Gardiner may call 207-441-7199 to find out how we might help you.

Bear Awareness Gardiner/Bear Creek Council, a volunteer organization, relies on donations and grants to purchase each bear can, YOUR bear can! We have provided one free bear-resistant can to each Gardiner resident since 2009. Each can costs \$300.

# FWP reminder: Be Bear Aware When Recreating Outdoors

Remove or secure food attractants at residences

HELENA – Bears are emerging from dens with the onset of spring, and people are headed outdoors should "Be Bear Aware."

Bears can be found throughout Montana. In recent years, grizzly bear populations have expanded and bears are sometimes found in historic ranges beyond western Montana

As bears begin foraging for food, people can avoid conflict by removing or securing food attractants such as garbage, bird feeders and pet food. The most common human-bear conflicts involve unsecured food attractants.


