THE GARDINER RANGER DISTRICT, of the Custer Gallatin NF, is hosting the Beaverhead–Deerlodge NF road crew to perform flood response work at Joe Brown Trailhead and Yankee Jim River Access. Flood debris will be removed and new gravel surfacing will be placed on the ramp and in the parking areas. **Yankee Jim River Access** will be reconstructed from April 19-29. Expect delays and intermittent closures at the site. **Joe Brown Trailhead** will be reconstructed and closed for portions of April 24-26. Select Yellowstone National Park roads open to public April 21

Visitors: *Expect winter conditions*

MAMMOTH HOT SPRINGS, WY – Beginning at 8 a.m. Friday, April 21, 2023, select roads in Yellowstone National Park will open to the public, weather permitting. Roads routinely open this time of year and remain open until Nov.1, when they close in preparation for the winter season.

On Saturday, April 22, entrance fees will be waived in celebration of [National Park Week](#).

Roads open April 21

- West Entrance (West Yellowstone, Montana) to Old Faithful (via Madison Junction)
- Mammoth Hot Springs to Old Faithful (via Norris Junction and Madison Junction)
- Norris Junction to Canyon Village
- Additional [park roads](#) will open throughout May, weather permitting.
- The park's North Entrance (Gardiner, Montana) and Northeast Entrance (Silver Gate and Cooke City, Montana) are open to all traffic with no restrictions. Both road corridors have been repaired after last year's [historic flood event](#).

Current Conditions

- Due to a severe winter of above-average snowpack and continued cold temperatures, wildlife such as bison, elk and moose are stressed and weak. Be mindful as they endure this hardest part of the year. Bison and elk often use roads as travel corridors when the snow is deep, and higher than usual snowbanks this year prevent them from easily moving off the road. Stay at least 100 yards away from bears and wolves, and 25 yards from all other wildlife. Do not crowd or push wildlife.
- There may be a high number of winter-killed carcasses due to the severity of the winter. When bears emerge from hibernation, they look for food and often feed on elk and bison that died over the winter. Sometimes, bears will react aggressively to encounters with people when feeding on carcasses. Protect yourself and bears. Stay alert, carry bear spray and know how to use it. Learn more about [bear safety](#).
- Come prepared. Services in the spring are limited. Visit [Operating Hours & Seasons](#) for area-specific services.
- Check the park's [current conditions](#) before arrival.

Road improvement projects

- Four major [road improvement projects](#) will occur this year. All four projects will cause delays (Lewis River Bridge, Old Faithful to West Thumb, Yellowstone River Bridge and Northeast Entrance Road). It's important that visitors plan accordingly for these delays located along the park's southern and northern road corridors. Drive slowly through road construction and be alert to workers, heavy equipment, wildlife and other hazards.

Stay informed

- Watch for quickly changing weather conditions and the possibility of temporary road closures. Many areas of the park are still experiencing winter conditions and snow and ice may cover sections of road. Check for road updates:

 - Receive Yellowstone road alerts on your mobile phone by texting "82190" to 888-777 (an automatic text reply will confirm receipt and provide instructions).
- Reduce wait times at park entrances. Buy a pass [online](#) ahead of time.

Hunting Permit Drawing Results Now Available

HELENA – The drawings for Montana deer and elk permits and for nonresident combination licenses are complete and applicants can find their results online.

You can see your results by visiting fwp.mt.gov, click on [MyFWP Login](#) in the upper righthand corner, then click on [Lookup Draw Results](#), [Register for Lists](#) tab on the left-hand menu, or login to your MyFWP account. You may also sign up for an account at myfwp.mt.gov. Applicants may also call any FWP Regional office or the licensing office at 406-444-2950.

For unsuccessful applicants, refunds will come in the form of a check in the mail. If you selected the option for your refund to be donated to the Block Management Program, you will not receive a check in the mail and your full refund amount will be donated.

For successful applicants, if you selected to receive your carcass tag(s) electronically, you may download your carcass tag(s) on your mobile device through your MyFWP account. Do not validate your tag until you have harvested an animal.

Deadline reminders: The deadline to apply for moose, bighorn sheep, mountain goat and bison is Monday, May 1; the deadline to apply for elk B, deer B, and antelope is Thursday, June 1. All applications must be completed online or at an FWP office. Most FWP offices with license sales are open Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

- Stop feeding the birds in spring and fall.
- VRBO and Air B&B hosts, please tell your guests to use only designated bear-resistant cans. We can help you get one. We have brochures about bear safety.

Yellowstone National Park's Mammoth Hot Springs Hotel Spring 2023 Opening Delayed; Flood-damaged Wastewater System Still Being Completed

Visitor services available in Mammoth Hot Springs

MAMMOTH HOT SPRINGS, WY – Yellowstone National Park's Mammoth Hot Springs Hotel spring 2023 opening has been delayed until the wastewater treatment system in the area is completed and operational. Due to the heavy winter and difficult construction conditions, the new system will not be operational by April 28 as originally planned, the scheduled Mammoth Hotel opening date. The park is working closely with contractors to complete the project as quickly as possible.

The [hotel closed](#) immediately after the 2022 [historic June flood](#) because of damage to the area's wastewater system. The North Entrance (Gardiner, Montana) and Northeast Entrance (Silver Gate and Cooke City, Montana) are open to all traffic with no restrictions. Both road corridors were repaired last fall following the flood.

Although the hotel will be closed to overnight guests temporarily, the hotel's gift shop, coffee and beverage service, and lobby will open as scheduled on April 28. Overnight accommodations will reopen immediately after construction of the wastewater system is completed. The hotel dining room and Terrace Grill will be temporarily closed and regularly scheduled tours departing from Mammoth Hotel will not be available.

All other services in [Mammoth Hot Springs](#) will be open including:

- Albright Visitor Center
- General Store
- Post Office
- Medical Clinic
- Gas Station

The opening of the Mammoth Campground will also be delayed until the wastewater system is operational. The campground closed immediately following the 2022 flood and remains closed because the campground lacks an outlet for wastewater.

All communities near Yellowstone are open year-round, with local businesses offering a wide range of overnight lodging and recreation opportunities. Visit [Gardiner, Montana](#); [Silver Gate and Cooke City, Montana](#); [Cody, Wyoming](#); [Jackson Hole, Wyoming](#); and [West Yellowstone, Montana](#).

In June 2022, unprecedented amounts of rainfall caused severe damage to the North Entrance Road between Mammoth Hot Springs and the park's North Entrance in Gardiner, Montana. In addition, a sewer line adjacent to the road that carried wastewater from Mammoth Hot Springs to a sewage treatment plant in Gardiner was ruptured. Staff quickly rerouted the wastewater into percolation ponds used between the 1930s and 1960s, allowing for summer day-use visitation and limited services.

Currently, a new wastewater treatment system is being built to serve the Mammoth Hot Springs area; however, this temporary system is not ready to support full hotel operations. Due to an above-average snowpack and cold temperatures this winter, construction of the system has proceeded slower than expected.

The park has authorized Yellowstone National Park Lodges to open other visitor accommodations earlier than normal to offset inconveniences to displaced guests with existing reservations for the Mammoth Hotel. Guests with reservations at the Mammoth Hotel will be offered opportunities to rebook at other Yellowstone National Park Lodges properties in the park based on available space.

Yellowstone staff are working to make the wastewater system operational and ensure it can handle expected use. It's important that the system is fully functional, safe and meets required environmental standards prior to the park reopening the hotel in Mammoth Hot Springs.

All other Yellowstone National Park Lodges properties will open as scheduled.

The hotel concessioner is in the process of notifying guests with reservations about the situation. Please visit [Yellowstone National Park Lodges' alerts](#) for reservation details.
