#### **Evening Temporary Closures** on Northeast Entrance Road in Yellowstone National Park the Week of June 5 and June 12

- A short section of Yellowstone National Park's Northeast Entrance Road in Lamar Canyon (between Tower Junction and Lamar Valley) will temporarily close from 7-9 p.m. on June 5, 7, 8, 12, 14 and 15.
- This segment of road will close so that construction crews can conduct safe blasting operations.
- During the 2022 historic flood, high water eroded the slope below this section of road rendering it not safe for use. To repair the damage, crews cut a temporary one-lane road into the hillside. Crews will blast further into the hillside this month to create a new two-lane road, which will be more resilient and able to withstand the effects of erosion and future flooding.
- In order to avoid additional erosion, this work will need to be completed as soon as possible. Once complete, the existing one-lane road will be removed and rehabilitated.

#### Background

- The Northeast Entrance Road closed immediately following the 2022 flood due to substantial damage in five places including this section.
- The road <u>reopened on Oct. 15, 2022</u>, and is open to visitor vehicle traffic year-round. It provides winter access to the communities of Cooke City/ Silver Gate in Montana and to Lamar Valley, a main attraction in the park.
- Stay informed about up-to-date road conditions in Yellowstone:



#### Top 10 Things to Know About Visiting Yellowstone National Park this Summer Season

MAMMOTH HOT SPRINGS, WY – If you plan to travel to Yellowstone National Park this summer, plan ahead to protect yourself and this wild and awe-inspiring place. Within the park's 2.2 million acres, visitors have unparalleled opportunities to observe wildlife in an intact ecosystem, explore geothermal areas that contain half the world's active geysers, and view geologic wonders like the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone River.

Listen and learn from park rangers by watching this <u>video</u>. Follow the top 10 things to know to enjoy your visit and protect the park for generations to come!

#### No Vehicle Reservations Required

Vehicle reservations are not required to enter the park – just a park entrance pass. Save time at entrance stations by <u>purchasing your pass online</u> before you arrive. Keep in mind that summer is busy, so be prepared for crowds at popular areas and lines at the entrance gates, in construction areas and at roadside wildlife sightings. Please be patient and enjoy your visit.

#### **Check Road Statuses**

Most park roads open to regular vehicles in mid-April and close to wheeled vehicles (cars, vans, motorcycles, etc.) in early November. Weather may necessitate closures at any time, however, so check the <u>park roads</u> page for more information about current park road status and traffic delays due to road improvement projects.

#### Plan Ahead

All campgrounds and lodging require a reservation and are usually fully well in advance of your trip. Operating hours and service levels can change with little notice. Check the latest information before coming to the park:

Current Conditions
Places to Go
Things to Do
Boat Inspections and Permits

#### Give Wildlife Room

Wild animals are dangerous if you get too close! People have been injured or killed by bears, bison and elk. Always maintain a minimum of 25 yards (23 m) from all wildlife and 100 yards (91 m) from bears and wolves. Learn how to watch wildlife safety and travel safely in bear country.

#### **Drive and Park Responsibly**

Observe posted speed limits and use pullouts to watch wildlife, take pictures and let other cars pass. Do not stop your vehicle in the road. When pulling over, be sure to park with all four tires fully to the right of the white line.

#### Stay on Boardwalks

People have been <u>severely injured or killed</u> by breaking through the thin ground in thermal basins or falling into hot springs.

#### **Enhance Your Experience**

Download the free National Park Service app (and offline content) before you arrive in the park.

#### **Expect Limited Connectivity**

Don't be surprised if you can't receive calls or texts, even in the few areas where you might have <u>cell reception</u>.

#### **Prepare for Weather Changes**

Unpredictability characterizes Yellowstone's weather. Expect big temperature swings, rain or snow during every month of the year. No matter when you visit, bring a warm jacket, rain gear and lots of layers. Check the <u>current</u> weather conditions.

#### Make the Most of Your Trip

Make it the trip of a lifetime by attending a <u>ranger</u> <u>program</u>, exploring the <u>Yellowstone Tribal Heritage Center</u>, participating in the free <u>Junior Ranger program</u> or checking out any of the <u>special events</u> happening in Yellowstone this year!




