Candlelight Tours Offered at Lewis & Clark Caverns State Park

Tickets can be purchased online

WHITEHALL – Lewis & Clark Caverns State Park will soon host holiday candlelight tours of the entire developed cave route.

This special event allows visitors to see and enjoy the caverns by the warm, festive glow of candle lanterns. Participants must make a reservation prior to their tour. Tours will be offered from Dec. 15-17 and Dec. 21-23. The starting times of these tours will vary, depending on park staffing for the day. However, all tours will be during the day, with a portion of the two-hour walking tour being outdoors along trails that may have snow and ice. Park staff will provide tour guides, candles, lanterns and hot drinks. The cost for this unique event is \$25 for visitors ages 15 and older, and \$15 for visitors ages 5 to 14. All participants must be at least 5 years of age. Nonresident visitors must pay an \$8-per-vehicle entrance fee as they enter the park. Tickets will be sold on a first-come, first-served basis and must be purchased online. To purchase tickets, visit fwp.mt.gov/stateparks/lewis-and-clark-caverns and click on "About The Park". No tickets will be sold at the park visitor center. Participants are encouraged to be prepared for winter conditions on roads and trails at the park. Lewis & Clark Caverns State Park is about 15 miles southeast of Whitehall, along Montana Highway 2. Cash Reward Increased to \$21K for Information on Wolverine Killed Illegally in Southwestern Montana

WISDOM – Several organizations have offered to contribute additional funding to raise the cash reward for information on a [wolverine killed illegally](#) northwest of Wisdom in November.

Donating organizations include the Animal Defense Fund, Trap Free Montana, Skyline Sportsmen in Butte, the Center for Biological Diversity, and FWP's TIP-MONT program. The combined reward offered from these organizations is \$21,500.

Game wardens received a report on Nov. 10 of a wolverine carcass found on U.S. Forest Service Road 7377 near Schultz Saddle and the Continental Divide, northwest of Wisdom. A game warden located the carcass and confirmed the animal had been shot, skinned and abandoned.

Wolverine harvest is not legal currently in Montana.
