Deadline for FWP’s New Migratory Bird Stamp Art Contest Extended to Jan. 31

HELENA – The deadline for Montana Fish, Wildlife & Park's new Migratory Bird Stamp art contest is now Jan. 31. The Wetlands Protection Advisory Council will select the winning piece of art in February. The winning artist will receive a \$2,000 cash prize and be featured on promotional materials throughout 2024.

In addition to the extended deadline, some changes have been made to contest rules, including artwork previously used in production or entered into any state or federal stamp competition can be submitted. Details on contest rules and entry information can be found [here](#).

The winning artwork will be on display in the Capitol in Helena and announced by Gov. Greg Gianforte in late February.

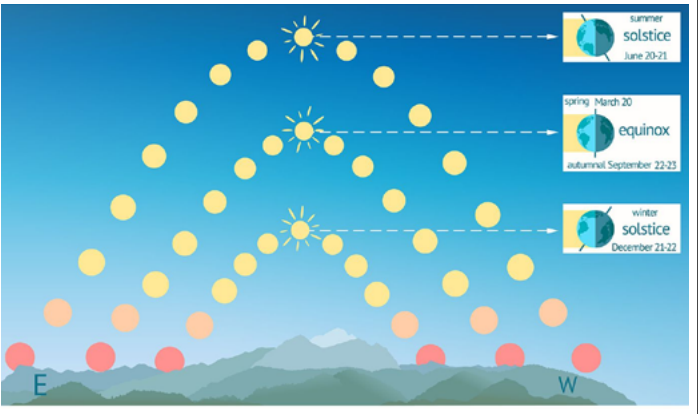
The 2024 migratory bird stamp will not be required to hunt migratory birds in Montana. To hunt migratory birds, hunters will need a current Montana migratory bird license and their federal duck stamp, the same as in years past.

However, beginning in 2024 those who purchase a migratory bird license will receive a free collectable sticker showing the winning artwork, information about the Migratory Bird Wetland Program and information about how to make additional contributions. Purchasing a migratory bird license is a great way to support wetland habitat conservation. FWP will work with the Montana Outdoor Legacy Foundation and other partners to provide other ways to donate to wetlands conservation. More information on other donation opportunities will be available in early 2024.

The 2024 Migratory Bird Stamp will help raise additional awareness of the importance of wetland habitat and the benefits to wildlife, landowners, and water quality. Wetlands are critical for many wildlife and aquatic species, as well as providing critical ecosystem functions like flood control, groundwater recharge and water purification. FWP’s [Migratory Bird Wetland Program](#) helps landowners and other conservation partners develop and fund projects that protect, conserve, enhance or create high-quality wetland habitat.

Winter Solstice 2023

The winter solstice — the precise moment when the Sun appears farthest south in the sky — happens at 8:27 p.m. on Thursday, December 2023 in the Northern Hemisphere. After this, the days will get start to get longer.

Yellowstone National Park's Winter Season Began Dec. 15, 2023

Top things for visitors to know about a winter visit

MAMMOTH HOT SPRINGS, WY – Yellowstone National Park's winter season began Friday, Dec. 15. Annually from mid-December until mid-March, visitors can travel most of the park's roads from the West, South, East and North entrances by approved [commercially guided snowmobiles and snowcoaches](#) and via the [non-commercially guided snowmobile access program](#).

Currently, there is limited snowfall on roads in the eastern, western and northern parts of the park. This means that visitors will be able to travel in the park, however, the type of transportation used on park roads by commercially guided snowmobile or snowcoach tour companies will depend on road conditions. Throughout the winter season, park staff will work closely with all operators and provide updates as conditions change.

Winter travel ends in mid-March when plowing crews begin to clear a winter's worth of snow. [Roads](#) will start to re-open to automobiles in mid-April.

Top Things to Know in Winter

- **Most Park Roads are Closed to Automobiles**

The only roads open year-round are between the North Entrance in Gardiner, Montana, and the Northeast Entrance in Cooke City/Silver Gate, Montana (via Mammoth Hot Springs, Tower Junction and Lamar Valley). Anticipate possible road closures due to quickly changing weather and dangerous driving conditions. Check the [road status map](#) before you leave. Drive cautiously and watch out for snowplows. Do not stop, stand, or walk in the road. Use a pullout if you need to stop for any reason.

- **Want to See Old Faithful?**

Park partners, concessioners and authorized businesses offer a variety of [guided tours](#) throughout the park during the winter months.

- **Services are Limited**

Most facilities are closed during winter. Check [winter operating dates](#) to see which visitor centers, stores, restaurants, lodges and warming huts are open.

- **Camping and Lodging**

Old Faithful Snow Lodge and Mammoth Hot Springs Hotel are open during winter. Make [reservations](#) as far in advance as possible. Lodging is also available in [nearby communities](#). There are no campgrounds open for the 2023/2024 winter season.

- **Prepare for Winter Conditions**

Winter temperatures range from zero to 20°F (-20°C to -5°C) throughout the day. Sub-zero temperatures are common, especially at night and at higher elevations. Check current [weather](#) conditions, pack proper [clothing and equipment](#) and review [winter safety tips](#).

- **Do Not Approach or Feed Wildlife**

Animals have the right of way. Expect to encounter bison and other wildlife on park roads. Slow down or pull over until they pass or move off the road. Stay 100 yards (91 m) from bears and wolves and 25 yards (23 m) from all other wildlife. The safest way to [view wildlife](#) is through a telephoto lens, a spotting scope or a pair of binoculars. Store food properly and be aware that in some areas, ravens have learned to unzip backpacks to obtain contents.

- **Stay on Boardwalks**

People have been severely injured or killed by breaking through thin ground in thermal basins or falling into hot springs. Exercise caution and wear traction aids over footwear when navigating snowy or icy boardwalks.

- **Enhance Your Experience**

Download the free [National Park Service App](#) (and offline content) before you arrive.

- **Connectivity is Limited**

You will likely not receive calls or texts, even in the few areas you have [cell reception](#).
