SCHOOL BUS DRIVERS NEEDED. Gardiner Public Schools is seeking applicants for School Bus Route Driver Substitute and Activities Bus Driver for the 24/25 school year, with potential for a Regular School Route Driver position for the 25/26 school year. Application Deadline for Deer and Elk Permits is April 1

HELENA – Don't wait to apply for deer and elk permits. The application deadline is April 1. Hunters can buy licenses and apply for permits on the [FWP website](#); click on "Buy and Apply."

Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks offers several tools to help hunters navigate the application process. The application process is different for residents and nonresidents, but FWP has [created instructional videos](#) to help with both kinds of customers.

Hunters and anglers can also take advantage of the [MyFWP mobile app](#). The app holds and displays licenses, permits and E-Tags, which can be downloaded and used in the field without cell service. To create a My FWP account, visit the [MyFWP login page](#).

FWP also has convenient resources for understanding bonus points and how they work.

Applicants have the option to reapply for the same offerings as last year with just a simple click, eliminating the need to search through previous applications.

Most FWP offices will be open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. The licensing call center will be open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. through April 1; after April 1, the hours will return to 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. The call center can be reached at 406-444-2950.
