Starting April 5, spring biking will open on the 49-mile stretch between the West Entrance and the North Entrance! 🚲

Although this road corridor remains closed to public vehicles, it won't be completely free of traffic. Cyclists will still encounter administrative traffic and construction vehicles, including heavy equipment and plows. All cyclists must ride single file on the right shoulder of the road and follow the same traffic laws as automobiles.



FWP Announces Public Comment Opportunities

HELENA – Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks is seeking public comment on the following environmental assessments (EA). For more information, including how to submit comments, click on the link provided or visit fwp.mt.gov/public-notices.

Mill Creek phase 2 – 5 Bar 6 draft CEA

Mill Creek (Park County) is a tributary to the Yellowstone River in the Paradise Valley. It is one of the remaining Yellowstone cutthroat trout strongholds outside of Yellowstone National Park. Past land management included channelization that pushed the channel to the westernmost edge of the valley. Lack of large wood and instream habitat complexity indicates that wood was removed, and the channel became simplified. Despite the limitations, the project area is an important spawning and rearing area for migratory Yellowstone cutthroat trout as it is upstream of dewatering in lower Mill Creek. This project is phase 2 and would continue the restoration on Mill Creek (1-mile section) by breaching a historical berm in strategic locations to restore floodplain connectivity, allow side channel formation and restore natural meadow and stream function. Log jams will be built to create habitat complexity. Reconnection is expected to encourage riparian plant growth. The goal is to improve in-stream and spawning habitat for Yellowstone cutthroat trout and other fish species and to enhance fishing opportunities. **Comment deadline: April 15**

NOTICE OF ANNUAL SCHOOL ELECTION: Notice is hereby given by the undersigned Clerk of Gardiner Public School District No. 7 & 4, Park County, State of Montana that the Annual School Election will be held on Tuesday, May 6, 2025, by mail ballot. Ballots may be returned to the following:

Location prior to and on Election Day: Park County Clerk & Recorder, located at 414 E Callender Street, Livingston, MT 59047 during the hours of 8:00 am until 8:00 pm

Electors will consider the following issues at the election:

- Proposition: a levy in the amount of \$50,000 for the High School General Fund.
- Trustee Election: Two (2) trustees for a three (3) year term and one (1) trustee for a one (1) year term. Trustees are to serve on the Board to represent both the elementary and the high school district.

A qualified registered elector who will be absent from the district during the time the election is being conducted may: a) vote in person in the election administrator's office as soon as the ballots are available and until noon the day before the ballots are scheduled to be mailed; b) make a written request, signed by the applicant and addressed to the election administrator, that the ballot be mailed to an address other than the address that appears on the registration card. The Park County Election Administrator's office is located at:

If you miss this regular registration deadline (30 days prior to the election), you may still register for the election by showing up at the county election office by noon on the day before election day.
