DID YOU KNOW?

1. Montana's income tax system has changed. Taxpayers will see changes to filing statuses, tax brackets, and the calculation of Montana taxable income.
2. As a result, employees should review their wage withholding to ensure they aren't withholding too much or too little.
3. The Department of Revenue has also updated the Montana wage withholding form (Form MW-4). All employees are encouraged to review their wage withholding amounts.

Gardiner Public School, Park County, Community Announcement

On election day, the school is asking taxpayers for a general fund levy in the amount of \$50,000. This request will very minimally impact your tax bill. The impact of the \$50,000 general fund levy passage will increase the taxes on a home with a market value of \$100,000 by approximately \$4.79 this year.

These funds will provide education for our children and if we lose the levy authority it would be detrimental. It could lead to reduced staffing and reduced resources. The general fund budget is determined by student enrollment and the amount of tuition we receive from Wyoming. Wyoming tuition covers the cost of the Wyoming students, which is just over 30% of our budget. Over the past seven years, Wyoming student enrollment has increased while Montana student enrollment has decreased.

In addition to the obstacles already mentioned above, the elementary technology levy voted five years ago will run out on June 30th. Our Board decided not to ask for this technology levy renewal this tax year. Because of this the school is already looking at a decreased budget for the 25-26 school year in the amount of \$50,000. The money needed for technology will come from the school reserves. Reserves are there for future capital projects and emergency building maintenance needs. Our reserves will last us only a handful of years at this pace and with continued spending increases and enrollment decreases, the number of reserves needed to bridge this gap will continue in the future. Our reserves would cover the deficit, but this is not a permanent solution.



Anglers Charged by Grizzly Bear in Centennial Valley

Fortunately, anglers were unharmed

CENTENNIAL VALLEY – Two anglers were reportedly charged by a grizzly bear Monday while they were fishing in Red Rock Creek on Red Rock Lakes National Wildlife Refuge.

The bear charged through thick brush, and one of the anglers shot at the bear in self-defense. Fortunately, the anglers were able to leave the area uninjured. It's unknown whether the bear was injured. Grizzly bear staff and game wardens with Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks searched the area Wednesday. No bears or carcasses were found. No further management action from FWP is planned. Refuge staff with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service have issued a [temporary closure](#) of a section of Red Rock Creek for public safety. The closure includes the portion of the creek between Elk Lake Road and Upper Red Rock Lake. The closure will remain in effect through May 5. Stream access east of the road remains open, and Elk Springs Creek has no closures in effect.

Be bear aware

Montana is bear country. Grizzly bear populations continue to become denser and more widespread in Montana, increasing the likelihood that residents and recreationists will encounter them in more places each year. Avoiding conflicts with bears is easier than dealing with conflicts. Here are some precautions to help residents, recreationists and people who work outdoors avoid negative bear encounters:

- Carry bear spray and be prepared to use it immediately.
- Travel in groups whenever possible and make noise, which can help alert bears to your presence.
- Stay away from animal carcasses, which often attract bears.
- Follow food storage orders from the applicable land management agency.
- If you encounter a bear, never approach it. Leave the area when it is safe to do so.
- Keep garbage, bird feeders, pet food and other attractants put away in a secure building. Keep garbage in a secure building until the day it is collected. Certified bear-resistant garbage containers are available in many areas.
- Never feed wildlife. Bears that become food conditioned lose their natural foraging behavior and pose threats to human safety. It is illegal to feed bears in Montana.

Though they have reached recovery levels in the Northern Continental Divide and Greater Yellowstone ecosystems, grizzly bears in the lower 48 states are listed as threatened under the Endangered Species Act. Management authority for grizzlies rests with the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service, working closely in Montana with FWP, the U.S. Forest Service, the National Park Service, the Bureau of Land Management, the U.S. Geological Survey, Wildlife Services, and Native American tribes. This collaboration happens through the [Interagency Grizzly Bear Committee](#).
