### Custer Gallatin National Forest Begins Scoping on Rendezvous Nordic Ski Area Improvements Project 30-day comment period starting April 12, 2023

BOZEMAN, MT — The Custer Gallatin National Forest announced a 30-day public scoping period to start the Rendezvous Nordic Ski Area Improvements Project. The scoping period begins a 30-day comment period starting April 12, 2023. The Rendezvous Nordic Ski Area is adjacent to the town of West Yellowstone in Gallatin County, Montana and consists of about 24 miles of gently rolling, groomed Nordic trails that wind through tall stands of lodgepole pines and open meadows. Created in 1978, the Rendezvous Ski Area is managed through a cooperative partnership between the Forest Service, the West Yellowstone Chamber of Commerce and the West Yellowstone Ski Education Foundation. The cooperative partnership created a new Master Development Plan for the Rendezvous Nordic Ski Area to provide direction for future management. "The Master Development Plan contains elements such as trail modifications and infrastructure improvements designed to meet the current and future needs of trail users," said Custer Gallatin National Forest Hebgen Lake District Ranger, Jason Brey. "Many of these elements require environmental analysis under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), and this 30-day comment period will kick off the NEPA process.' "The success of the Rendezvous Nordic Ski Area over the past 45 years has always depended on collaboration between the public, West Yellowstone community partners, and the Forest Service, and we value your feedback!" said Custer Gallatin National Forest NEPA Team Leader, Amanda Williams. "Comments received during scoping will help us refine the proposed action and identify issues for analysis. 2023 Spring Bicycling Between Yellowstone National Park's West Entrance and Mammoth Hot Springs Began April 7

Cyclists - Anticipate higher than usual snowbanks and stressed wildlife on roads; Do not crowd or push wildlife on roads and be prepared to wait or turn around

MAMMOTH HOT SPRINGS, WY – Bicyclists willing to brave the <u>unpredictable weather</u> of spring in Yellowstone National Park can ride 49 miles between the West Entrance in West Yellowstone, Montana, and Mammoth Hot Springs.

The following <u>roads</u> between the West Entrance and Mammoth Hot Springs will open to bicycling:

- West Entrance to Madison Junction
- Madison Junction to Norris Junction
- Norris Junction to Mammoth Hot Springs

As conditions allow, bicycles will also be permitted from the East Entrance to the east end of Sylvan Pass (6 miles). Check the <u>biking web page</u> for updates.

Bicycles are not allowed on the remaining park roads until they start to open to public automobiles at 8 a.m. Friday, April 21. Check <u>park roads</u> for spring opening dates

**Ride Safely** 

- Bears, bison, elk, moose and other wildlife use roads as travel corridors when the snow is deep. They are stressed and weak due to the severe winter of aboveaverage snowpack and continued cold temperatures. Be mindful as they endure this hardest part of the year. Higher than usual snowbanks prevent them from easily moving off the road. Do not crowd or push wildlife and be prepared to wait or turn around.
- Stay at least 100 yards away from bears and wolves and 25 yards away from all other wildlife.
- Carry bear spray and know how to use it.
- Travel during daylight hours only.
- Ride single file and use extreme caution. Expect administrative vehicles such as snowplows, heavy equipment, contractor and employee traffic. Roadway shoulders are narrow, and curves can limit visibility
- Watch for quickly changing weather conditions and the possibility of temporary road closures. Snow and ice may cover sections of road.
- No services will be available, except limited restrooms. Plan for self-rescue or repair. Cell phone coverage throughout the park is sparse and unreliable for communicating emergencies.
- Prepare to spend an extended period in winter conditions in the event of a mechanical breakdown, injury or other emergency.
